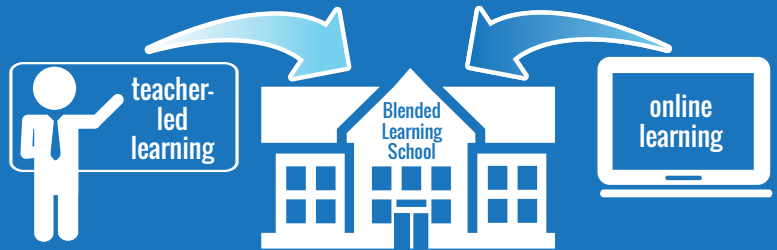


## We want to hear from you about
